Mario: Partners night for the very special event “George” Sierra ex Exchange student from 36 years ago.

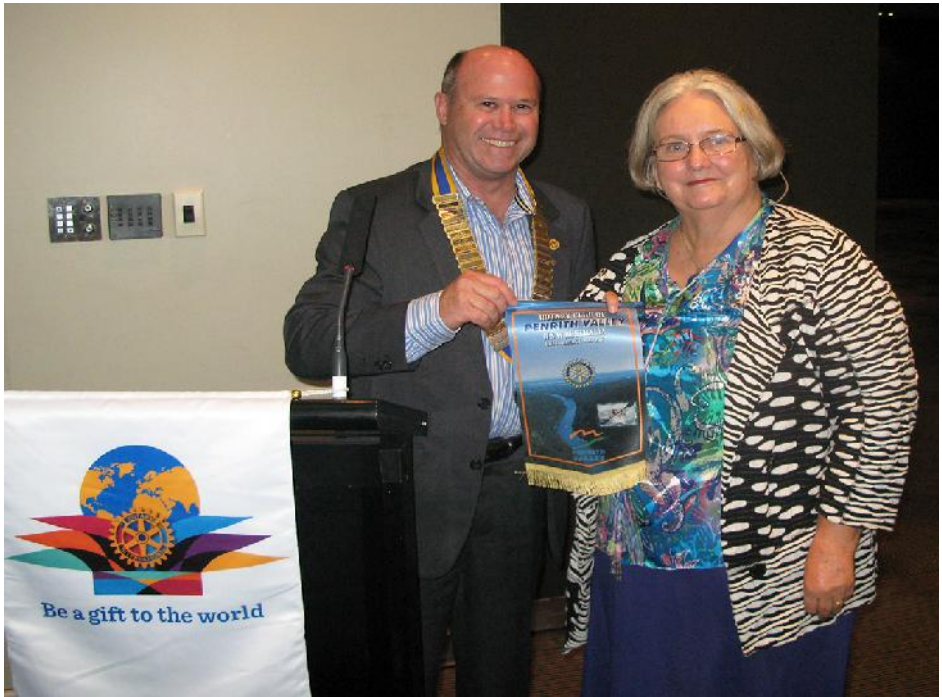
Jim: Carols are on 13th Dec 2015 . Mario suggested a detailed planning meeting for 25th Nov to get us ready.
